Employee & Family Assistance

For some reason we have had a sudden spike in employees arriving at work in an unfit condition. From time to time life can become overwhelming and sometimes people turn to alcohol and drugs to help them cope. Soon it becomes a lifestyle and that lifestyle begins to come to work. When this happens people begin a spiral that results in feelings of helplessness, which reinforces the lifestyle. There are options available. All employees and their family members are entitled to access the Employee & Family Assistance Program (EFAP) which is provided free of charge. At no time will any information be released to The City without your informed consent. Should you require treatment at a facility, you will be entitled to sick and accident benefits, but you may have to pay facility fees. Seasonal employees are allowed to access the EFAP for up to 3 months after layoff.

The EFAP program may be reached at 261-5888 or 1-888-815-9995 for employees living outside the Calgary calling area. The program is available 24/7 with evening and weekend appointments available upon request.

Remember - the longest journey begins with a single step.

Waterworks/Wastewater Integration

After several false starts the Waterworks/Wastewater project is back on track. We are currently working on verifying seniority and relief lists while The City is working on possible pay banding solutions to address the combined 45 classifications and 11 rates of pay. 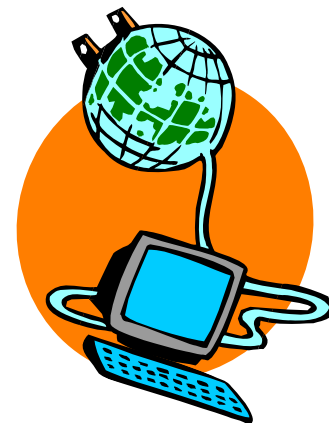
We are currently in the process of creating a website for CUPE Local 37.
