All the money raised goes directly to STARS air ambulance to provide much needed emergency care to Southern Alberta.

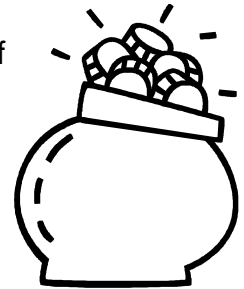


The Executive of CUPE Local 38 remind you all to drive safe and take care this summer and enjoy your time off with family and friends.
